Sports Premium Planned Budget Spending 2016/ 2017

What is Sports Premium?

The Government is providing funding of £150million per annum for the academic years 2013-2020 to provide new substantial primary school sport funding. This funding is being jointly provided by the Departments of Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see the money going directly to primary head teachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. The sport funding can only be spent on sport and PE provision in school, but we have the freedom to choose how we do this.

Funding for schools is calculated by the number of primary aged pupils (between the ages of 5 and 11) as at the annual schools census in January 2016. All schools with 17 or more primary-aged pupils receive a lump sum of £8,000, plus a premium of £5 per pupil. St Andrew's received £8,866 Sports Premium income for 2016/17. The school invested an additional £8,761 to give a total spend for the year of £17,627 for the full year. Primarily we use our Sports Premium funding by employing Mrs Julie Small, a qualified primary teacher with a passion for PE, to deliver, lead and coordinate the following:
